---

### - PRAY -

Prayer is an important part of our daily lives as individuals, families or as a community. During Lent, we set aside time to pray, to re-commit our life to Christ, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection. Meditating on the Passion of Christ allows us to enter more deeply into the Paschal Mystery of Christ.

### - FAST -

As Catholics, we are asked to fast during Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. We are also called to abstain from meat on Fridays during this season. Abstaining from meat and/or other things that we can give up is encouraged as they are forms of sacrifices that remind us that only God can satisfy our deepest hunger and need.

### - ALMS -

Almsgiving is an act of Christian charity. As Christians, we are called to be conscious of the needs of others, particularly the poor & hungry. As recipients of God's love and mercy, we respond by sharing what we have to those in need. Fasting helps us be in solidarity with the hungry & should compel us to reach out to them.
