“SALUBONG.” Is an Easter Sunday pre-dawn ceremony that reenacts the Risen Christ's meeting with His mother. The celebration starts with two dawn religious processions — a group of men with the statue of the risen Christ and a group of women with the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary covered in black veil — coming from opposite directions and meeting (“salubong” in Filipino) in front of the church. An angel, who in the past would be a girl hanging from a tree, will then sing the Hallelujah and unveil the statue of Mary. Once again, thank you FMT for hosting this year’s Salubong.
